Sebesta Blomberg Ranked #25 on Giants List

MINNEAPOLIS, MN — September 8, 2009 — *Consulting-Specifying Engineer* (www.csemag.com) magazine ranked Sebesta Blomberg 25th on the annual Giants list. In addition, Sebesta Blomberg ranked #1 of the top ten commissioning firms in the country.

Published in the August issue of *Consulting-Specifying Engineer*, the annual MEP Giants list features the top mechanical, electrical, and plumbing (MEP) engineering firms, listed by total MEP design revenue. Firms included on the list conduct systems engineering and commissioning services for non-residential construction and renovation projects.

“A total of 95 firms are represented in this year’s MEP Giants list, with MEP design revenue totaling more than \$4.4 billion. The total MEP design revenue is down only 3% from 2007 and there are five fewer firms on the list. The recession threw engineering firms a curve ball fourth quarter of 2008, but they showed resiliency by adding services in commissioning and maintenance/repair/operations (MRO). The green market and attention to energy efficiency upgrades will help engineering firms in 2010,” said Michael Ivanovich, editor-in-chief of *Consulting-Specifying Engineer*.
